NBI - NEW DORM PROGRESS

As you can see, the Nicolet Bible Institute Dorm project is moving right along – nearing the 50% completion point! It's exciting to see the progress being made on a daily basis. This dorm will be a tremendous

asset to the NBI program, allowing all of one gender to be under the same roof with their RA. In addition, there will a central gathering spot for developing community. Future plans in-

clude a second dorm so that both genders have the same "student life" experience at Nicolet Bible Institute.

Though the primary use for this building is a dorm for NBI students, it will also be used to house both Youth and Family Campers in the summer months. This will become one of the most used and versatile buildings at camp.

Funding for the project stands at 66% with approximately \$100,000 remaining on the \$300,000 total. We are asking God to provide all the funds needed to have the building debt-free upon completion.



As fast as the dorm in going up, so is the incoming NBI Class of 2019 filling up! We are experiencing our strongest fall enrollment surge to date. If you or someone you know is interested in what Nicolet Bible Institute has
